- * **Full Paper:** Full paper should be written within 3000 word limit.
- * **Author(s):** Provide Author’s name, affiliation mobile and e-mail. In case of multiple authors, mention corresponding author.
- * **Text:** Times New Roman, Text size 11, Heading size 12
- * **Referencing Style:** APA 6th Edition.
