#### ✦ Introduction/Background

The history of teacher education in India is like a continuous flowing river and we may say that the present-day system of teacher education has been and is being strengthened by several springs and rivulet of the time since its beginning. It is a resultant product of several educational forces of the past centuries. Keeping this in mind, School of Education; Department of Education and Extension, Department of Physical Education, Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, and Indian Association of Teacher Education (IATE) are organizing the 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual National Conference on the theme of "Teacher Development: Concerns and Perspectives" between April 03-04, 2021 at the School of Education; Department of Education & Extension, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

#### ✦ About the Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU)

Savitribai Phule Pune University (formerly University of Pune) was established on February 10, 1949 under the Poona University Act. The university houses 52 academic departments. It is popularly known as the 'Oxford of the East'. It has about 307 recognized research institutes and 950 affiliated colleges offering graduate and under-graduate courses.
